- A personal (professional) master curriculum based on:
 - existing courses in master curricula,
 - capita selecta hosted by University Research groups and company R&D teams
 - and the final Challenge Thesis
- **Partners**: Universities, research institutes, industries, governments, etcetera

- Challenge Research Community: Courses, Capita selecta, Winter / summer schools, Work conferences, Masterclasses, Design meetings, ..
